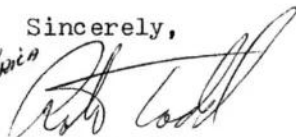

contact you.

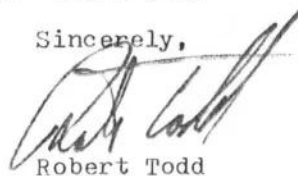
It is my understanding that the Brazilian Secret
Police investigated the incident which occurred on November
4, 1957, at Fort Itaipu, in the vicinity of Santos, Sao
Paulo, when two guards were struck by an intolerable heat
wave while watching an unidentified flying object.

Would it be at all possible for you to aid me in
obtaining a copy of the report prepared on the above inci-
dent by the Brazilian Secret Police? I would also be very
interested in knowing what your Government's official posi-
tion is regarding unidentified flying objects or so-called
"Flying Saucers."

Finally, it is also my understanding that the November
4, 1957, incident at Fort Itaipu was also investigated by
North American Officials. Would it be at all possible for
you to identify the agencies to which these officials be-
longed?

Any assistance you might be able to offer on these
matters would be greatly appreciated. Thank you.
